The Healing Land

Synopsis

The Healing Land aims to describe the growth, use and human stories around the many "superfoods" traditionally used within Peru's rich cultural and bio-diverse regions. Cataloging both the nutritional and cultural significance of these foods may help to return traditional diets, in many cases lost centuries ago, and counter the malnutrition that is still prevalent in the country. Peru has an urgent need to protect the wide variety of plants and plant knowledge, for itself and the rest of the world.

These Pre-Columbian crops represent not only a magnificent resource of nutrition for the existing population, but may hold the keys to the future of human survival. Earth has an abundance of plants that have been used in ancient cultures to provide sustenance, healing and longevity. Yet, paradoxically, in this new century, humanity is experiencing increasing rates of malnutrition, obesity and chronic diseases. Recently, traditional Peruvian staples have been labeled "super foods" the demand for which are increasing dramatically on world markets. Examples are, Maca (prized for its energy giving and aphrodisiac qualities), Quinoa (discovered in the 1970s by NASA to feed astronauts), Kiwicha (Amaranth), Andean tubers, blue/purple corn, Amazonian rainforest fruits such as and Aguaje, Ungurahui and Açaí, and a huge lexicon of medicinal plants are all enjoying huge popularity for their perceived health benefits worldwide.

The film explores the reasons why this occurred, from a botanical, historical and cultural perspective, going back 5000 years. Plants have always played a significant role in Peruvian healthcare, from pre-Hispanic culture to the present day. We propose to promote the consumption of highly nutritious Peruvian foods among consumers, generating an opportunity for farmers to preserve and grow these ancestral species. Climate change will have an impact on our food resources that could be devastating, forcing us to create awareness among the population and generate policies to prevent genetic erosion of agro-diversity that sustains and enhances our diets. We aim to impact the public and decision makers on the need to conserve agro-diversity for our health and that of future generations.

This resource – the plants and the knowledge of how to use them is being lost at an alarming rate, and this loss is mostly an irreversible process. 25% of the world's medicines have their origin in the Amazon region, and less than 1% of the trees and plants in the Amazon region have been tested by scientists.¹ In these plant riches humanity could find the secrets to its future health and wellbeing.

Traditional foods

The theme of importance throughout this panorama is the need to protect the wide variety of plants with high nutritional and curative properties that Peru can provide the world, both now and in the future. It is urgent to have healthy and nutritious food to improve the diet of our population affected by metabolic syndromes that cause serious diseases such as obesity, diabetes and hypertension.

The documentary seeks to share the nutritional benefits and human stories around the cultivation and consumption of foods such as Maca, Tara, Lucuma, Algarrobo, Pacae, Tarwi, Quinoa, Kiwicha, Cañihua, Purple Corn, Aguaymanto, Ugurahui, Aguaje, Acai.

Traditional Knowledge

One of the most pertinent questions is whether should we allow the gradual loss of traditional knowledge – and their eventual merging with a modern, westernized culture and value systems? In recent years, there has been a rise in scientific and ecological projects dedicated to preserving, retrieving and transmitting ancestral knowledge, as well as the investigation of the benefits of biodiversity for human health.

Juan Duran – Biografía

Juan Duran descubrió la magia del cine mientras estudiaba cine en la Universidad de Lima. La visión del gran documental “Nanook el Esquimal” de Robert Flaherty (1922) fue determinante en su decisión de seguir la carrera de documentalista y cineasta.

Sus primeras experiencias fueron en el área de producción de cortos documentales donde conoció todas las etapas de la producción de un film. Mas adelante optó por la imagen y la cámara. Desde entonces, como camarógrafo y fotógrafo de cine, Juan ha participado en un buen número de documentales en 16mm, 35mm y video, filmados en diferentes países de Latinoamérica y Estados Unidos y para diferentes medios entre

ellos, National Geographic, Skylight Pictures y CBS Productions. Estos documentales han sido exhibidos en diferentes países, como Perú, EEUU, Francia, Alemania, Suecia y Holanda, habiendo sido algunos de estos premiados internacionalmente.

Además de su trabajo como documentalista, Juan ha participado en 30 largometrajes y un gran numero de comerciales, lo que lo ha llevado a experimentar con un universo de ópticas y condiciones desafiantes de luz.

Juan Duran – Biography

Juan Duran discovered the magic of film while studying film at the University of Lima. The vision of the documentary “Nanook of the North” directed by Robert Flaherty (1922) was determinant in his decision to pursue a career as a documentary maker and cinematographer.

His first experiences were in the area of production of short films where he learned about all the stages of the production of a film. Later he became more involved with the image and the camera. Since then, as a cameraman and cinematographer, Juan has worked in a number of documentaries shot in 35mm, 16mm and video, filmed in different countries of Latin America and the United States for different media, among them National Geographic, Skylight Pictures y CBS Productions. These documentaries have been exhibited in different countries such as Peru, USA, France, Germany, Sweden and Holland, having some of them received international awards.

In addition to his work as a documentary maker, Juan has participated in 32 feature films and a number of commercials. This has led him to experience with a variety of optics and challenging lighting conditions.
